

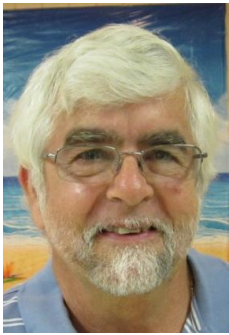

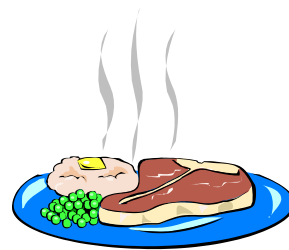
We meet the second Friday of every month.
